The **Bay State Banner** is an African-American owned news publication that reports on the political, economic, social and cultural issues that are of interest to communities of color in Boston and throughout New England. The Banner has been the newspaper of record for this community, chronicling the struggles and successes of the last 42 years. It is the Banner's belief that an informed community is better able to assume responsibility for its own welfare and progress.

Started in 1965 by Melvin B. Miller, a graduate of Harvard College and Columbia Law School, the Banner provides its estimated 120,000 weekly readers with reports on a mix of local, national and international news and cultural events.

Exhibitor Space Information

Exhibitor areas are 6'x2', consisting of a skirted table and two chairs. The corporate sponsor will receive two skirted tables and four chairs for an exhibitor area of 12' x 2'. The company is responsible for supplying materials and adorning the space as necessary.

Exhibitor space will be assigned upon receipt of payment. All payment must be received within thirty (30) days of invoice date. Exhibitor space is not guaranteed until payment has been received.

The contact person will receive a confirmation letter, which include additional exhibitor information that is specific to the particular exhibitor opportunity chosen.

Terms of Agreement

Agreement to Terms: The Exhibitor, on behalf of their organization, agrees to abide by the following rules and any amendments that may be made by the Bay State Banner.

Assignment of Space: The Bay State Banner will provide and notify all exhibitors of space assignments two weeks prior to the event. Timely registrants will be given preference.

Use of Exhibit Space: No Exhibitor shall assign, sublet or share the whole or any part of the assigned exhibitor space. All exhibits are confined to the exhibit space and should not obstruct the general view nor hide other exhibits.

Indemnification: Exhibitor agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the Bay State Banner from any suit, action, and claim whatsoever, including personal injury or property damage, related to or arising from the Exhibitor's participation in the career fair. The Bay State Banner, its agents and employees are not liable for loss, theft or damage to the property of the Exhibitor and its employees or representatives. It is the Exhibitor's responsibility to maintain proper insurance coverage.

Force Majeure: The Bay State Banner reserves the authority to determine whether the Recruit & Retain: Power Diversity Career Expo 2008 venue is fit or unsuitable for occupancy as a result of fire, flood, acts of nature, acts of war, strike, lock-out, labor dispute, riot or any other cause or agency over which the Banner has no control. Should the Bay State Banner decide that it is necessary to cancel, postpone, move the career fair or alter the schedule, the Banner shall not be liable to reimburse the Exhibitor with any respect to any directly or indirectly resulting alleged damages and losses.

Payment: To reserve your exhibitor opportunity, please complete and submit your registration form along with full payment to the Bay State Banner (Attention: Recruit & Retain) within 30 days of submitting your registration. Exhibitor space is NOT guaranteed until payment is received and processed.

Cancellation Policy: To receive a refund, cancellations must be received a minimum of 4 weeks prior to the event via fax, mail or phone. Deadline for cancellations is March 3, 2008. Cancellations received after this deadline will be subject to the "no show" policy.

No Show Policy: Exhibitors who do not attend show up at Recruit & Retain: Power Diversity Career Expo 2008 (and have not cancelled their registrations) forfeit their entire registration fee. To avoid being considered a "no show," please cancel before the deadline.

Exhibitor Representatives: Each exhibiting organization must name at least one person to be its representative in connection with installation, operation and removal of the exhibit. Badges are required for admittance to the exhibit area.

Exhibitor Logos: Should the Exhibitor submit its logo late or in an improper format, the Bay State Banner will not be required to satisfy the Exhibitor Opportunity as stated in this offer. Every effort will be made to provide alternate exposure for the Exhibitor as deemed feasible by the Bay State Banner. Exhibitors will be informed of logo submission deadlines and requirements in their Exhibitor Confirmation Letter.
